

Abstract

The article focuses on the results of the research of phonetic interference in the Russian speech of the Amur Evenks. According to the research, deviations from the Russian standard pronunciation in producing the affricates are the following: replacing of the affricates /tʂ/ and /tʃʲ/ with the fricative consonants /sʰ/ and /ʃʲ:/ respectively, as well as pronouncing the occlusive consonant /tʲ/ instead of the affricate /tʃʲ/.
