THE MODEL OF MIGRATION DISCOURSE

Abstract

The current article aims to analyze migration discourse as the main object for studies performed in the new direction in linguistics – migration linguistics. The relevance of migration discourse research is determined by rapidly growing migration flows. Migration affects all spheres of human activities and it is the cause of language conflict aggravation and increase of verbal aggression, which detrimental consequences cannot be managed only by political or legal measures.
